

What is PBIS?

A PBIS OVERVIEW:

PBIS, or Positive Behavior Intervention and Support, is a three-tier framework used by schools to support all students. As a framework, schools are able to use PBIS to fit the needs of their school, students, and staff.

The over-arching goal of PBIS is to develop, implement, and maintain common language for school-wide expectations, and to explicitly teach students these expectations to decrease exclusionary discipline and improve student and teacher outcomes.

THE DIFFERENCE

What PBIS is:

- ✓ A three-tiered approach to provide support to **all students**
- ✓ Evidence based program
- ✓ Explicit teaching and re-teaching expectations
- ✓ A tool to build a positive school climate and culture

What PBIS isn't:

- ✗ A packaged curriculum or quick-fix
- ✗ Abandonment of discipline
- ✗ Bribery for good behavior or ignoring inappropriate behavior
- ✗ Just for one type of school



THREE-TIER APPROACH:

School-based PBIS teams work to identify students who would benefit from targeted or individualized interventions, and continually reevaluate data to ensure students are receiving adequate behavior support.

What is PBIS Rewards?

PBIS REWARDS OVERVIEW:

The goal of PBIS is to create a **positive school climate, in which students learn and grow**. However, school climate can vary widely from school to school. A number of factors affect school climate, including school location, neighborhood culture, instructional methods, student diversity, and school administration.

Employing the PBIS framework can make the task more manageable. The key to an effective PBIS implementation is an "all-in" mentality among teachers and administrators in a school. For PBIS to produce positive change in a school's climate, it needs to be employed schoolwide and with consistency.
