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Overview

What is PBIS Rewards?

PBIS Rewards is a Software-as-a-Service solution that provides an automated schoolwide PBIS management system. Our system simplifies the implementation and tracking of the PBIS framework within a school. With PBIS Rewards, school administration can clearly see how teachers are utilizing PBIS and how PBIS is improving school culture.

PBIS Rewards is easy to use, fun for both students and staff, and provides accountability for everyone in the school. Our suite of PBIS Apps includes a Parent App that gives parents a view into how their child is doing with respect to the PBIS program. There is also a Student App that allows students to track their points, referrals, and CICO as well as redeem points via events, raffles, and stores.

Why do I need reports?

School climate influences academic performance in numerous ways. When you concentrate on building positive relationships between students and staff, you lay the groundwork for a focused learning atmosphere. A schoolwide framework built around positive behavior interventions and supports helps to equip students with the tools they need to develop socially and emotionally.

Tracking the effectiveness of this schoolwide effort relies on accurate reporting. Most schools must report disciplinary data to their state education agencies as well as to the U.S. Department of Education. This data helps to shape education policy on district, state, and federal levels. Within each individual school, however, this data can help to completely transform a school's climate.

Accurate and effective data collection on the individual school level can provide timely feedback for fine-tuning a positive behavior initiative. Reports generated at this level can tell you if teachers are using the program equitably and who may benefit from coaching. These reports can help you to adjust your policies and assess the impact of these adjustments within a short time frame.

What's inside this manual?

This manual will walk through all the reports found in the PBIS Rewards Intervention Reports. Each report discussed in this manual is illustrated with a screenshot and includes details about the data and usage of the report.

Who can see the reports?




Anyone who has Admin rights or Reports View permission can see the Interventions Dashboard data. These rights can be given in the Staff page by an admin. Click on the permissions column (with the key). You can select what permissions each user should have.

What's on the dashboard?

The Interventions Dashboard will give the user a quick snapshot of Check-In/Check-Out progress. Additional reports can be found at the bottom of the screen. No need to spend hours looking for important data. We have taken some of the most popular reports and made an easy-to-read dashboard with thumbnails of the data. Most of these thumbnail graphics contain a Details button that will allow the user to dig into more thorough data. Each report can now be easily printed (including the graphics) or exported to a CSV file. There are currently 10 reports users can utilize to track behavior in their school.

How do I change the data I can see?

Once inside the details of each report, there is a left-hand side menu. Each report contains a variety of reporting options for choosing the date range. Depending on the specific report, users can customize grade levels, students, and data displayed so that graph shows exactly what they need to see.




The Intervention Reports – Dashboard Reports

Current Students in CICO

The Current Students in CICO report will show how many current students are active in CICO. The small chart on the dashboard will update every time the page is refreshed. The larger graph can be accessed from the details button located inside the thumbnail under the number. This report will allow administrators to see all students on a CICO plan. Administrators can see the big picture of current status for each student. (CICO Coaches can see this same graph in their report dashboard, as well.)



The small chart to the left shows the current number of students in Check-In/Check-Out (CICO) on the dashboard. When a user selects the DETAILS button, they have the option to see all the data and customize the report details as seen in the chart below.






Percent of Students Meeting Goal: Previous Day

The Percent of Students Meeting Goal: Previous Day report will show how many current students reached their CICO goal on the previous day. The small chart on the dashboard will update every time the page is refreshed. The larger graph can be accessed from the details button located inside the thumbnail under the number. This report will allow administrators to see all students on a CICO plan. Administrators can see the current status of each plan, the CICO goal, Points received by the student, and the percent of the goal that was reached.




The small chart to the left shows the current percentage of students meeting their goal the previous day in Check-In/Check-Out (CICO) on the dashboard. When a user selects the DETAILS button, they have the option to see all the data and customize the report details as seen in the chart below.






Average Number of Days on a CICO Plan

The Average Number of Days on a CICO Plan report will show the average number of days an active plan has been in place for students on the dashboard. However, after choosing the Details button, more detailed data will be displayed. Administrators will be able to see the current students on a CICO plan. They can sort this list by grade, coach, start date, end date, and total days on a plan. This will enable administrators to track each student in Tier 2.




The small chart to the left shows the average number of days students are on an active CICO plan. When a user selects the DETAILS button, they have the option to see all the data and customize the report details as seen in the chart below.





Students by Tier



The Students by Tier shows the three tiers in the MTSS pyramid. Administrators can quickly see the number of students that are active in each tier. Students are listed based on the highest tier in which they are active.




CICO Plans per Month

The CICO Plans per Month report will show how many active CICO plans happened during the months listed. The small chart on the dashboard will update every time the page is refreshed. The larger graph can be accessed from the details button located inside the thumbnail under the number. This report will allow administrators to see trends in active CICO plans. It will also help administrators be more proactive in their efforts surrounding Tier 2 supports.








The Intervention Reports – Additional Reports Available

Daily Report Overview




The Daily Report Overview will allow Administrators to quickly see the compliance rate of the Check-In/Check-Out process. They can see how many students were absent (excused), how many current students have active plans, and how many coach Check-Ins were completed for that day. This is the same report that can be seen with the "Current Students in CICO" dashboard button.






Student Goal Tracking




The Student Goal Tracking Report allows users the ability to track how individual students are doing on their customizable goals. Users can see student totals by individual day or see a summary of points for each goal. This report will allow coaches and administrators to see progress over time for a goal.






CICO Point Goal Trend




The CICO Point Goal Trend report will show how a student is progressing against their set goal. Administrators can see how often a student is consistently meeting or exceeding the point goal set for them. Likewise, admins can see if the goal has not been reached. This data will inform users when a student is ready to progress out of Tier 2.






Class Period Trend




The Class Period Trend Report allows Administrators to see where Check-In/Check-Out is the most successful. Why are staff great at reviewing goals and awarding points during 1st through 3rd periods but there is a sudden drop-off at period 4? This report will allow users to dig into the data to address consistency and fidelity within the CICO process.






Teacher Check-Ins.




The Teacher Check-In Report can be utilized to see how each teacher is awarding active CICO/Tier 2 students. Administrators can see how many total points a teacher has awarded, the number of Check-Ins that have been completed, the number of students that have been given points towards their goal, and the average points given per student. This table can be sorted by a variety of dates and can show all plans or just active ones.






Custom Interventions




The Custom Interventions report can be utilized to see all the custom interventions created in the student dashboard. Administrators can see custom interventions based on all students, favorited groups, grades or by tier. Attachments that go along with the interventions can be viewed and student names can be selected to see all student data from the student dashboard.






SEL Check by Student




The SEL Check by Student report can be utilized to see the percent of SEL checks based on each status.

Administrators can see how many total checks were given in each status based on a given time frame and by group or grade. Additionally, admin can use the High Frequency List Summary to see the top ten students with the highest risk checks or the top ten students that have had the longest time since the last check. Numbers in this report can be selected to see a list of those specific checks and student names can be selected to see all student data from the student dashboard.






SEL Check by Staff



The SEL Check by Staff report can be utilized to see the percent of SEL checks based on each status. Administrators can see how many total checks were given by staff in each status based on a given time frame. Numbers in this report can be selected to see a list of those specific checks and student names can be selected to see all student data from the student dashboard.
