




UNDER THE GROUPS TAB

“Random” Button

Wondering what the “Random” button does? The Random button enables you to select a student at random, either from your entire group or from a selection of students within your group. Some ideas for practical applications of the **Random** button:

- ◆ Randomly select a student to call on during a class.
- ◆ When the whole class or certain group of students are meeting expectations, select one of the students at random using the button. Then, assign a point to them!



UNDER THE SETTINGS TAB

Point Bubbles

Did you know that you can customize your groups to show or hide the student point balances? On the main menu, click **Settings**. Once there, go to **Options** and find the **Display Student Balance** box. You can turn this feature on and off.

- ◆ Turn on for easy reference when looking at your groups page privately.
- ◆ Turn off when displaying the groups tab to easily award points as you teach. This keeps point totals private for students.

UNDER THE STUDENTS TAB

Student Info

On the main menu, click **Students**. This is where teachers and staff can manage student data easily within the system. This dashboard also offers an array of quick links for viewing student data housed in the PBIS Rewards platform. Once you search for a student, clicking on the information button will lead you to a dashboard.

Here, you will find details about their points, view their interventions, and even add customized interventions. You can also track the student's referral data if your school or district has purchased the BRS add-on.
