WORKPLACE REWARDS


Known within the PBIS Rewards system and Staff App as "Teacher Rewards," Workplace Rewards for Teachers is an excellent tool for recognizing teachers and staff for furthering your school's core values. Your staff does amazing things each day to build positive school climate, including establishing clear guidelines for behavior. While that's a professional best practice for classroom management, teachers also appreciate being recognized for their hard work and positivity!

Positive recognition helps to build a better work culture. Recognizing staff members and teachers for a job well done has never been easier! From the Workplace Rewards for Teachers dashboard, staff can request points for themselves under the **Request** tab. This is especially helpful for acknowledging behaviors and actions related to their school's core values or expectations.



REWARDING STAFF

Need to acknowledge a colleague for going above and beyond? Simple! Just head over to the **Recommend** tab to search for a co-worker's name, choose the value category, and write a brief description of why they deserve this recognition. The best part? Staff can choose to post their recommendation to the wall on the dashboard. Not only will that teacher earn points, they will also be publicly recognized for all of your staff to see! In the same way that students receive recognition for their positive behavioral choices in PBIS Rewards, teachers and staff earn points in Workplace Rewards for Teachers. These points can be used to purchase perks like snacks, class coverage coupons, gift cards, or whatever awards the professionals at your school would love!
